Board of Health Meeting on May 13

The Gallatin City-County Board of Health will hold a meeting on Wednesday, May 13 at 7 a.m. The Board will discuss and decide on amending the local emergency rule to harmonize with <u>Gov. Bullock's revisions</u> to Phase 1 reopening guidelines that allow for the reopening of gyms, museums and theaters starting May 15.

The meeting will also include a report from Gallatin City-County Health Officer Matt Kelley.

Due to social distancing requirements, the Board is encouraging the public to submit comments through email, view the meeting by streaming it online, and participate live by calling in. Details on how to participate virtually can be found <u>here</u>.
